

COSFOM Project

helps to restore forest and water resources for communities to be prepared for the impact of climate change

- 25 villages participate in Ukhrul District
- Project staff is based in the District Forest Office in Ukhrul



Water Resource Conservation Committee guides the work in the village

- Each household in the village is a member of the Water Resource Conservation Group
- Each village elected one WRCC
- The WRCC members are elected for up to 4 years
- If you need any information, contact your WRCC or any district project staff for help





Water Conservation

through springshed revival, river conservation, and rainwater harvest

- The project helps to find and protect the source of your village spring
- Villagers build small ponds or trenches to catch rainwater at the source
- Protection helps to increase amount and quality of water for your village to live
- Rainwater harvest from roofs contribute to increased water supply





Forest Protection and rehabilitation through community nurseries and reforestation

- Community nurseries are producing seedlings for bringing back the forests
- Forest closures are protected by village warden to allow the forest to become healthy again
- Riverbanks are reforested to avoid erosion and to improve water quality to increase amount of fish



Livelihood Improvementthrough community infrastructure and Self-Help Groups

- Women are supported to improve their income through technical training and financial support
- Each SHG identifies their economic activities and is provided with seed money
- The project supports with marketing and sale of products
